- 10. Failure to comply with the direction of college faculty and staff, including failure to provide student identification and evidence of enrollment, if appropriately requested (220 – page 26)
- 11. Unauthorized possession, or duplication of keys to any campus premises (222 – page 26)
- 12. Smoking or chewing tobacco in District or College facilities or vehicles (224 – page 27)
- 13. Possession, consumption, intoxication, or distribution (on campus) of alcohol, controlled substances or unlawful drugs (off-campus, if college-related) (228, 230 – page 27)
- 14. Possession of firearms, explosives, other weapons or dangerous chemicals (232 – page 27)
- 15. Conduct which is disorderly, lewd, or indecent; aiding or abetting such conduct (234 – page 27)
- 16. Violating any of the computer and electronic information use rules and regulations, including prohibited access into sexually explicit internet sites (236, 238 – page 27, 28)
- 17. Discrimination on the basis of race, national or ethnic origin, creed, age, sex, marital status, veteran's status, sexual orientation or disability including racial or sexual harassment as defined. (242, 246 – page 28, 29)
